

The Ten Commandments as Elucidated by Yeshua the Messiah

Yahweh is your God; you shall have no other deities. Yahweh is the one true God and there is no other.

You shall not make objects [idols] in order to bow down to them as if they were deities. Do not make gods out of false teachings and false traditions, for this is equivalent to idolatry.

You shall not use the Name of Yahweh your God in a worthless manner. Revere the Holy Name of My Father, but do not hide it, for there is salvation in His Name.

Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. You shall labor six days, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to Yahweh your God. The Sabbath begins at the evening of Friday — that is, at its sunset, and concludes after sundown on Saturday.

Honour your father and your mother. You will be blessed if you take care of your father and your mother during their old age and sickness. Do not mistreat the elderly, do not deride them because of their frailty or disabilities.

You shall not murder. You shall not terminate the life of any living person, regardless of that person's age. Do not abort a child in its mother's womb, for it is a living, human being at its conception.

You shall not commit adultery. Do not be sexually unfaithful to your spouse, and do not be unfaithful in your vows. Uphold one another through various trials in life.

You shall not steal. Do not take that which does not belong to you. You will be required to repay what you took in the World to Come.

You shall not give false testimony against your neighbour. Do not lie about your brothers, sisters or others, whether they are of My flock or not. Do not bring your brothers and sisters in the faith to court, as it is sinful to drag one another before the worldly authorities. If you have been wronged and amends can not be made, and if it has caused severe harm to you or your loved ones then the matter should be brought to the attention of worldly authorities, but in doing so, do not lie about the situation or make any other misrepresentation concerning the facts.

You shall not covet anything that is not yours. Greed is a tool of the evil one to take your feet off the path of righteousness. Do not allow your heart to seek after worldly riches. Instead, search for the riches of your Father in the Scriptures.

If you have committed any transgressions against these Laws, quickly seek forgiveness of your Father who is in heaven, and as far as possible make amends with persons that you sinned against.

Worship Yahweh your God alone, and love your neighbor unconditionally. These two commandments are the hinges of all the other Commandments throughout the Scriptures. Do not replace the Father with ideas, philosophies and arguments about His nature. Doing so eventually leads to doubt, unfaithfulness and idolatry. Once you begin doubting, you begin breaking all of the Commandments. Repent before it is too late.

These Commandments are not difficult to follow. If you have trouble understanding them, ask the Father for wisdom. He will send His guiding spirits to assist you in understanding. Pray for wisdom.

Follow the Commandments and you will be raised up in the Kingdom of My Father. Help others to follow these Commandments so they may advance in their knowledge of the Father. By assisting others, you too shall advance in your spiritual nature.

If you follow these Commandments, I will remain with you and the Spirit of Truth will teach you all that is necessary for your advancement in the Kingdom of My Father.
